The **Win The Battle Foundation** is offering **\$1000 to \$3000** scholarships* to High School Athletes in the Arvada/Westminster area who are pursuing post-high school education.

Eligibility- Applicants must meet all the requirements listed below:

1. Must be a young adult cancer survivor or a young adult that has been affected by an immediate family member with cancer.
2. Participated in High School Athletics or Athletic Support Activities (i.e., Band, Cheer, Trainer). Eligibility does not require College athletic participation.
3. Must be a High School Senior at Ralston Valley, Standley Lake, Pomona, Arvada, Arvada West or Faith Christian.
4. Planning to attend an accredited college, university or vocational institution in pursuit of an associate, bachelor, master's, doctorate or certificate as of the Fall 2021 semester.

Criteria - Applicants will be evaluated based on the items below:

1. An essay displaying a "Win The Battle" attitude with respect to your cancer experience. Include the role your athletic/activity participation played in your cancer experience.
2. Commitment to continuing education.

 - Attending High School and current grade.
 - GPA
 - Post-High School education goals and Fall 2020 enrollment plans.
 - Sports/Activities participated in while attending High School.
 - Essay telling how cancer has affected you and/or your family and the determination to "Win The Battle"!

The entry deadline for the Fall 2021 Scholarship is June 17, 2021. Scholarship awards will be announced on July 17, 2021.

*Multiple scholarships may be awarded.
